

Cucamonga Creek, as indicated above, Mill Creek is designated as Cucamonga Creek just upstream of Chino–Corona Road. **Cucamonga Creek, Reach 1** extends from this “confluence” to the point where 23rd Street crosses the channel in the city of Upland. The segment upstream of this location is designated as **Cucamonga Creek Reach 2**. Cucamonga Creek, Reach 1 flows from north to south, across the central part of the Chino Basin area, and is concrete–lined along the bottom and banks throughout its length. As with Mill Creek, Prado Area, baseflow in Cucamonga Creek consists primarily of effluent from IEUA RP-1, and nuisance runoff. Cucamonga Creek, Reach 1 was added to the 303(d) list in 1998.
