



SANTA ANA WATERSHED PROJECT AUTHORITY LIQUID WASTE HAULER DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL

Thank-you for your interest in the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA) Brine Line. Instructions to assist in the completion of the Liquid Waste Hauler Permit Application are listed below. As a SAWPA permitted liquid waste hauler, your company will be allowed to operate within the entire SAWPA service territory. This includes four Brine Line Collection Stations at the following locations:

Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA)

Western Municipal Water District (WMWD)

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD)

Upon issuance of your permit, each of your driver's will be required to attend an orientation session at the individual Collection Stations. This orientation can be coordinated with the individual collection stations.

In addition to a completed permit application, please submit a letter to SAWPA, on company letterhead, which identifies each driver and the respective driver's license number.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Your company must carry the following insurance to be permitted by SAWPA.

Consolidated Insurance Requirements for Waste Haulers

	\$2,000,000 General Aggregate	IEUA, WMWD, EMWD, VALLEY DISTRICT and SAWPA must be named as additional insured by way of physical endorsement form, not just language on the certificate.
Commercial Auto Insurance	\$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit	
Workers' Compensation	\$1,000,000 per each accident	A "Waiver of Subrogation" by way of physical endorsement form, not just language on the certificate must be provided.
Pollution Liability	\$1,000,000	

WASTEWATER GENERATORS

You must include with your application a list of those wastewater generators that intend to use your services to dispose of their wastewater. You will need to coordinate with the wastewater generators to obtain the indicated information. Please note that you will only be permitted to dispose of the generators waste at the Brine Line Collection Station(s) designated on their permit and subsequently reflected on your permit.

FEES

The fee for a SAWPA Liquid Waste Hauler Discharge Permit is \$150.00 per year. This fee will be invoiced to your company upon permit issuance. There is no fee for 1) adding additional generators to your permit application, 2) updating vehicle information or 3) updating driver's names and driver's license numbers.
